

Where do we stand?

COME RES:

- **facilitates** the market uptake of RES-E by supporting, with a set of specific activities, the implementation of the provisions for RECs as defined in RED II to be transposed by June 2021
- **assesses** “enabling factors” and aids the development of RECs in 9 European countries
- **covers** different socio-technical systems including community PV, wind (onshore), storage and integrated solutions
